## Year 6 Swimming - Summer Term 2018



Dear Parents/Carers,

Our Year 6 swimming programme begins on **Monday 9<sup>th</sup> July**. We will then go swimming on Tuesday 10<sup>th</sup> July, Wednesday 11<sup>th</sup> July, Friday 13th July, Monday 16<sup>th</sup> July, Tuesday, 17th July, Wednesday 18<sup>th</sup> July and the last session will be on Friday 20<sup>th</sup> July.

Children will leave school at 10:15 and swim between 10:45 and 11:15, returning to school by 11:45.

Girls must wear a full swimming costume (no bikinis please) and boys must wear swimming trunks or <u>close fitting</u> swimming shorts that are above the knee - the instructors at the baths are very strict about this and <u>will not</u> allow boys to swim with baggy shorts or shorts over the knee. All long hair must be tied back away from their face.

Children who need inhalers <u>must</u> bring them. Swimming and the humid pool environment may lead to a child needing to use their inhaler. As part of our risk assessment, if a child does not bring their inhaler they will not be allowed to go.

All children will need **a towel**. <u>We recommend that the children do not wear goggles, but</u> <u>if your child needs them for a medical reason, we will need **written consent** from you for <u>the instructors at the baths to make a decision if they can be worn.</u></u>
