Dear Parent/Carers,

This term, year 3 and 4 are continuing their focus on The Stone Age. We have planned a trip to Brackenhurst Campus (3rd December) to tie in with our History topic. Please remember to return your reply slip and pay for this on squid if you haven't yet done so. This trip will also support cross-curricular links with writing in English, as the children will be writing a diary entry from the perspective of a Stone Age child. In science, children will be learning about solids, liquids and gases with a focus on water and how it helps us to stay alive. In maths we will be continuing to look at the four operations focusing on multiplication and division as well as learning about measuring length, area and perimeter.

In PE we will be focusing on gymnastics. To support learning we have a specialist gymnastics coach coming into school to deliver a session for each class. Please make sure that children bring their P.E kits back to school so that they are prepared. Please also ensure that they have appropriate footwear for indoor and outdoor activities.

Below is a list of important things to remember:

- **Forest school is on a Wednesday morning** - children need old clothes, wellies and a waterproof coat
- **Homework** - at least one piece of Creative homework is expected and is due on a Wednesday when children will present it to the class
- **P.E** - children will need indoor/outdoor PE kits in school for PE which is on a Tuesday afternoon
- **Spelling tests** are weekly and conducted on a Friday
- **Mentions assembly** is on a Friday afternoon

Please make sure that your child reads 5 times a week and that you record this in the reading section of their diary.
