Dear Parent/Carers,

This half term, year 3 will be reading Enid Blyton's 'Enchanted Wood' as their class story. Their English and Big Read sessions will revolve around this narrative; looking particularly at descriptive writing, the build-up of characters and settings and the elements included in a fantasy narrative. The children will then be writing their own narrative based on the features they need to include.

In Geography, the children will be looking at the Mediterranean! We will be looking at the climate, food, language and art. The children will then have a Mediterranean day!

In Science we will be exploring electricity; where it comes from, what we use it for and how to create and draw circuits. Our PE is focusing on dance: making our own sequences of movements and exploring how dance can help us stay fit and healthy.

We will also be visiting Brackenhurst on 28th January for our stone age day, which we will use to write diary entries.
