Dear Parent/Carers,

This half term, year 4 will be reading Cressida Cowell's 'How to Train Your Dragon' as their class story. Their English sessions will revolve around this narrative; looking particularly at descriptive writing, the build-up of characters and settings and the elements included in a fantasy narrative. The children will then be writing their own narrative based on the features they need to include.

In Geography, the learning question for this half term is, 'Why do so many people go to The Mediterranean for holidays?'. We will be researching Mediterranean countries to learn about why they are so attractive for holidays focusing on weather, food and geographical features such as the Mediterranean sea.

In Science we will be learning about electricity answering questions such as: Why is electricity so important? How do circuits work? What are circuits made up of? Our PE focus for this half term is dance. Please make sure children have full P.E kit in school so that they are prepared.

Below is a list of important things to remember for you and your child...
