I enjoy reading, writing and speaking	Which open ended questions would you ask about the Viking civilisation? Write down at least 5.	Read and research the history of a famous inventor. What did they invent and how has it been used?	Create a leaflet, which tells you similarities and difference between the Anglo-Saxons and the Vikings.	Create a 3D scene for a fairy tale- will it be for a Fairy Tale with a Twist?	Write a fairy tale with a twist and read it someone- what do they think? Can you think of an alternate ending?
I enjoy working with numbers	Find out about the runes different system and explain what they are.	Write ten calculations using the runes numerals. Don't forget the answers.	Create a net for a Viking house. Remember to research what they looked like.	Create an illustrated timeline of the Viking civilisation, including key events.	Use the Runes numerals to write and solve 5 word problems.
I enjoy being scientific	List the sections of a science investigation which you must do when writing one. E.g. The Hypothesis.	Write up an investigation about how friction works.	Identify and compare different positions in your house, for where the best place is to evaporate water.	Create and carry out your own investigation. Make sure you consider what you need to change and keep the same to make it fair (variables).	Write an evaluation for an investigation which you have completed- what worked well? What would you change? Take pictures!
I enjoy painting, drawing and visualising	Draw and label a Viking soldier – think about the equipment they had.	Paint a mural similar to the Mayan murals.	Make a Mayan calendar and show how it differs from ours.	Create a sculpture which contains an egg- make it colourful! This can go on display on our Easter Celebration Day- 5 th April.	Create a model of a Viking ship and evaluate the success.
I enjoy being active and doing hands-on activities	Make up a warm up activity that can be used in PE.	Learn a typical Viking war dance- can you perform it to the class?	Create your own dance and perform it to a group of children and analyse how effective it has been.	Make an Easter bonnet, which you can wear on our Easter Celebration Day- 5 th April.	Create a model of a Viking settlement. Provide detailed labels to show what each building is and who might live there.
