### **School Lunches**

Due to increased costs, it is necessary to increase the cost of a school lunch to £2.50 per day from 4<sup>th</sup> June 2024. I am sure you will agree that this is still good value for money as the children have a variety of meals to choose from and the food is good quality. The cost of our meals will still remain significantly lower than schools in the local area, some are charging £2.95 and £3.00 per meal.

You will also have received a letter from Mr Norrie, our CEO, informing you that the cost of a school lunch will increase to £2.80 per day, from September 2024.
