Dear Parents and Carers,

I would like to thank you all for your patience and understanding in these very difficult times. Staff at the Academy are working hard to adapt the building and our practices and procedures to ensure we can safely welcome your child back to school. It is really important that the children realise that school will be very different to how they remember it in March.

We are hoping to re-open our Year 6 class on Monday 8th June but we will confirm this on Friday 5th June by text message. There are quite a few changes that have been made and they are explained below.

Groupings

The children in Year 6 will be divided into three groups; Miss Graney (supported by Mrs Newby), Mrs Wilson and Mrs Chipp will lead the groups. Mrs Frow will continue to provide cover for Miss Graney's PPA and leadership time. Once the children are in their groups, they will not mix with children from other groups and they will not be able to change groups. These are *The Bubbles* the Government refer to. Miss Graney's group will be in Ash Class, Mrs Wilson's in Oak and Mrs Chipp's in Beech.

Social Distancing

Work stations have been arranged to provide a distance of two meters between children. There are extra markings on the floor and signs, both inside and out, to help remind children of social distancing.

Staggered start/end to the day.

Year 6 will come to school and leave at two different times. Group one and three will arrive at 8.40am and leave at 2.55pm. Group 2 will arrive at 8.50am and leave at 3.05pm. We will let you know your child's group and times in the text message. All Year 6 must use the gate in the parent car park only. If you would like your child to walk home alone, please email the admin email address to let us know as parents are responsible for their own child, once they leave the school premises. I am sorry to say that parents and carers are not allowed on the school premises until further notice.

Breakfast Club and After School Club

Unfortunately, we are not able to provide a breakfast club or an after school club for the foreseeable future.

Lunches

Children are allowed to bring their own packed lunch if they wish, this will be stored at their work station. Children who receive free school meals will be provided with a sandwich lunch. Parents are also able to buy a sandwich lunch for their child and pay for it using Squid, in the normal way. Lunches will be brought to the classrooms and children will eat at their work stations so for this reason we are unable to provide hot meals. I am hoping the weather will be sunny and the children can have lots of picnics!

Snacks

We are not able to provide snacks at the moment so please could you send your child with a healthy snack for break time.



Drinks

Please send your child with a non-fizzy drink each day. Water fountains are out of use and children will not be able to re-fill their water bottles. We have a supply of bottled water, if needed.

Uniform

Uniform is optional but children must wear clean clothes every day to help reduce the risk of infection. Please ensure your child wears suitable footwear.

PE and Forest School

Children will be taking part in both PE and Forest School at some point each week but they will not be able to bring kit to school to change into. Please see below for the timetable so children can come to school suitably dressed.
