First of all, I would like to say how delighted we are to have the children back with us. Secondly, I would like to introduce myself as your child's new class teacher - Miss Barratt ☺ We are also very lucky to have Mrs Burdon, as our class teaching assistant, in our class every morning and on Friday afternoons. We are looking forward to an exciting year ahead and have developed a curriculum which will broaden the children's understanding of the world in a fun and interactive way as well as support the transition from what education they experienced during lockdown to coming back into school full time. Our curriculum also gives us the opportunity to take part in interesting experiences in order to support our learning. This term we will be pulling our topic work through our English and learning all about the prehistoric times, including the Stone Age! We will also be reading 'The Stone Age Boy' to support our topic further. In Maths, we will be focusing on place value, calculations and time.

In Science we will be learning all about experiments and how we conduct them, as well as exploring our digestive systems and how a healthy diet supports them! In PE, the children will be taking part in Dance and exploring how they can use their bodies to travel in different ways and create different movements. Throughout this curriculum, we will also be teaching your children how to be ready to learn and safe online.
