Dear Parents and Carers,

It has been a very busy two weeks at the Academy. The children worked extremely hard during our Pixl test week and they have all enjoyed taking part in circus skills and fun sports days this week.

## **Swimming**

As you are all aware, the Government did not lift the current restrictions, as planned. This now means that, due to Lammas Leisure Centre's restrictions, we are unable to take the whole school swimming at the end of term.

We have re-arranged our plans and we will be taking Years 3 and 4 (Silver Birch Class, Willow Class and Maple Class) every morning during the weeks commencing Monday 12<sup>th</sup> July and Monday 19<sup>th</sup> July.

We will also be taking Year 6 for eight sessions. Ash Class will swim Monday to Thursday afternoons during the week commencing 12<sup>th</sup> July and Hazel Class will swim Monday to Thursday afternoons during the week commencing 19<sup>th</sup> July.

Unfortunately, we will not be able to take Year 5 (Beech Class and Oak Class) until next term. I am sorry if this causes disappointment but this is beyond our control.

If you are able to help, with any of our sessions, please let your child's class teacher know via Class Dojo or call the main Academy Office. Thank you for your understanding; we really appreciate your support.

## **Annual Reports to Parents and Carers**
