Year 6 SATs

For the first time since the pandemic, Year 6 children are required to take the End of Key Stage 2 Standard Assessment Tests (SATs). The children have worked extremely hard to prepare for these tests, so it is important that we all support them during this week and that Year 6 children attend every day.
