All children will need to bring a bottle of water to school to keep themselves hydrated throughout the morning. Please also remember to send sun cream and a hat in case it is hot.

All children must wear their Skegby Junior Academy uniform PE kit. Football shirts/kits should not be worn. Please enter by the gate in the parent car park. I would like to remind everyone that smoking and vaping are not allowed on school premises, this includes the parent carpark.

For safeguarding reasons, all children need to stay on their side of the track and not join you on the parent side.

Reporting a Child's Absence

If your child is too ill to attend school, please call the main Academy Office, before 9am, to let us know. The phone lines are often very busy before school begins so please leave a message. Please do not use the Dojo messaging service to report a child's absence as the admin staff do not have access to this and teachers cannot check messages when they are teaching.

Dojo Messages

Many parents use the Dojo messaging service to keep in contact with their child's class teacher. This is really useful and thank you for doing so. However, I need to remind everyone that there is a restriction on the hours in which this service is available, in order to allow teachers quality time in the evenings and at weekends with their families. If you need to contact a class teacher, please do so between 7.30am and 5.00pm, Monday to Fridays only. Many thanks for your understanding in this matter.

Cycle Helmets

If your child comes to school on their bike or their scooter, they need to wear a helmet to keep them safe. Helmets can be stored safely in the school office; children can hand them in as they go into school and collect them at the end of the day.
