Work at home information:

This year, we are launching Bedrock Vocabulary, which is a fabulous interactive programme that develops the children's vocabulary. We are using it in school and would like the children to use it alongside their school learning at home. 5 dojo points will be given to the children who complete 15 minutes across the week - it can be in small sessions of 5 minutes. Any device can be used to access this app, as long as the internet is available.

For their maths, we use Times Tables Rock Stars (TTRS) to help improve their times table knowledge. Again, we expect 15 minutes across the week to spend practising their maths skills. 5 dojos will be awarded for those who complete this 😊
